

Weekly Outlook: Rainfall: 2-8 May 2018




Figure 1: Expected precipitation 2-8 May 2018.

Dry weather expected over most of South Africa this week. A cold front is expected to make landfall on Monday bringing rainfall to the Western Cape and western Eastern Cape on Monday and Tuesday. Up to 40 mm expected along the southern coastline of South Africa.

Average Minimum Temperatures: 2-8 May 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 2-8 May 2018.

Average Maximum Temperatures: 2-8 May 2018




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 2-8 May 2018.
